The Topeka Round-Up Club's Saddle Up horse camps are perfect for beginner through advanced riders ages 7 and up. Campers learn English riding, horsemanship and horse care through age-appropriate activities. Each day, participants will have a group riding lesson in addition to other activities.

About the Instructor

Kathy Childs has been a part of the horse industry for over 35 years. She is certified with the British Horse Society. Her hunter, jumper and dressage riders range from beginners to competitive riders. She and her husband also breed KWPN sport-horses.

Riding Levels

Beginner: No experience through riders walking, trotting and cantering on the flat.

Intermediate: Able to walk, trot and canter securely, and jump small courses at the canter

Advanced: Riders who are jumping at least 2'6" courses and showing.

Camp Details

TRC facilities include indoor, outdoor and jumping arenas as well as a climate-controlled clubhouse. Riding will happen rain or shine. Other activities may be held inside or outside depending on weather.

Requirements

Each day, riders will need:

- Hard soled boots with a 1" heel
- Long pants
- Riding helmet (school helmets are available)
- Sack lunch and snack
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen

Details

All camps are 5 days long. Camp begins at 9 and ends at 3 each day. More advanced riders may be asked to ride earlier. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due 10 days prior to the start of camp. Cost is \$325 for 5 days, \$275 for current TRC members.
